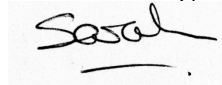

1. There were apologies for absence received from PCSO Anthony Boswell, PC Shaun Jakins and Cllr Kath Potter.
2. There were no Declaration of Members Interest.
3. Public speaking –
 - Resident raised via WhatsApp a query about what was going to happen to Beeley Old Pottery. The Clerk has spoken to Chatsworth and they have been exploring a reuse as residential accommodation and are currently in discussion with PDNPA about what this might look like. When an application is finalised the Parish Council will be notified.
 - Cllr Susan Hobson:
 - Attended a number of events at the Church on run up to Christmas which were lovely
 - Is in communication with the Clerk regarding various issues outstanding in the village around the roads and drains.
 - Received a grit provision request but this needs to come from the Parish Council. Cllr Hornsby raised concern about the state of the Beeley Hilltop road when the weather is bad and is made worse by the off roaders that come through 'enjoying the conditions'. He wondered if some grit could be provided to help keep the road clear for his tankers. Clerk will email DCC. Clerk
 - Chatsworth Christmas Market traffic issues will be discussed at the wash up meeting when it is set. Please report any issues to the Clerk.

- Chesterfield Road Landslip timescale emailed to the village was noted.
- Mayor’s Transport Plan Consultation – Cllr Webster updated the meeting on the Peak Park Summit and the plans to have smaller buses on rural roads and improvements to the roads to allow the public transport to run. It was agreed to respond saying “The ideas in the Transport Plan are great if the road network can support it due to the poor surfacing”.
- Derbyshire Fire & Rescue Service Consultation on Community Risk Management Plan and Budget. No comments.
- District Wide Housing Needs Analysis was noted. Most of the issues seem to be in the towns.
- Nature Futures Event: Co-Creating a Vision for Nature in the Peak District Dales (24 January 2026) – Cllr Webster to attend
- Peak District National Park Local Plan Review. No comments.
- DDDC and DCC Local Government Review – No update.
- Upcoming Changes to Bus Operations & Collaboration on Bus Shelters moving to the Mayor’s office.

- DALC November forum – 26th November – Cllr Grivil found it very informative. There was information about village halls, use of precepts, etc. Cllr Grivil felt reassured we were doing everything correctly.
- Parish & Town Council Liaison Forum – 8th December – No one attended.
- Wild beaver reintroduction consultation – 12th January – The Clerk attended this and shared the leaflets she picked up. An interesting project looking at the potential of releasing Beavers on the tributaries to the Derwent. This is very much in the investigation stage and Derbyshire Wildlife Trust would like to hear everyone’s views and are holding a number of events including at the DALC January Forum. Chatsworth are running an event with them on 20th January for Tenant farmers.
- Peak Cluster Phase 1 Consultation – 13th January – Cllr Mills listened to it online. Not going to affect Beeley Parish but an interesting project. To remove the Carbon Dioxide emissions. A pipeline with structures to compress the gas as it moves along and lead it to the coast. It will be possible for others to join the pipeline in the future.
